

Naples Premier Surgery Center Financial Information

Facility Charges

The facility has one fee that covers the following items: nursing, technician and related services; use of the facility; testing for certain lab tests performed at the surgery center such as glucose (blood sugar), pregnancy, and hemoglobin; medications administered before, during and after your surgery while in the facility; surgical supplies used by the physician and staff; equipment used in the facility; surgical dressings; implants, except those specifically classified as premium implants that require additional patient payment.

The facility charge does **NOT** include pre-procedure tests, surgeon professional fee, anesthesia professional fee, pathology studies or special supplies. All co-pays, deductibles and co-insurance are due at the time of admission as determined by your insurance benefits pertaining to ambulatory surgery centers. Cosmetic procedures and self-pay accounts require full payment (100%) at the time of admission. If special payment arrangements are necessary, please call us at (239) 263-7750 prior to the day of surgery. Cash, Checks, Money Orders, MasterCard, Visa, and Discover are accepted forms of payment.

Personalized Estimate of Expected Charges

Patients and prospective patients may request from this facility and other health care providers a more personalized estimate of charges and other information including specific contact information prior to service. Our estimate will be based upon the procedure your physician tells us that he or she plans to perform and the insurance information that you provide to us. We will contact your Insurer to determine your eligibility for the procedure and will then base our estimate upon what the insurer tells us about the payment they will make for the procedure.

Uninsured patients may also receive a fair estimate for the total expected facility charges of any non-emergency service. An uninsured patient is one who does not have insurance coverage for hospital services by a third party like Medicare, Medicaid, Workers Compensation or another insurance company. Other common terms used when referring to uninsured patients are: Self Pay and Private Pay.

The procedure your physician actually performs may differ from the initial one planned based upon your medical condition at the time of the procedure. Since we cannot predict the change, the estimate will be based upon the planned procedure as scheduled by your physician.

You may pay less or more for this procedure or service at another facility or in another health care setting. Please contact the Billing Department at 239-263-7750 to find out if the facility is considered an in-network provider with your insurance.

Transparency in Healthcare

The Florida Agency for Health Care Administration (Agency) launched [Florida Health Price Finder](https://price.healthfinder.fl.gov/), a new health care transparency tool for consumers. The website can be accessed at <https://price.healthfinder.fl.gov/>

The website allows consumers and caregivers to look up the average amounts paid by Florida insurance plans for a “care bundle” i.e. specific service or procedure, giving them a better estimate of their total out-of-pocket expenses. The average amounts paid by insurance plans are based on billions of lines of claims data from three Florida health plans.

Now, with this new tool, and in conjunction with working with their respective insurance plans, Floridians have the opportunity to get a much better estimate of out-of-pocket costs for specific services.

Financial Assistance Arrangements

We only schedule procedures at this facility by physicians who are on the medical staff at the facility. If your physician has determined that special financial assistance may be warranted and the physician agrees to those special financial arrangements for his or her services, you may be eligible for special financial assistance at the facility.

If your physician or the physician’s office staff have agreed to provide special financial assistance to you for a procedure the physician wants to schedule at this facility, please contact us. We will require you to complete an application for financial assistance that provides us information about your income and expenses. This will allow us to access your need and qualifications for special financial assistance. Confirmation of eligibility includes verification of your household income through paycheck stubs, receipts for payment of mortgage or rent and utilities, last year’s tax filing, and information regarding changes since the last tax filing occurred. We follow the most recent poverty guidelines set by the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services.

Since these special financial arrangements do not apply to all patients, each patient should request individualized information particular to his or her financial situation.

Bills from Separate Providers

Services provided at Naples Premier Surgery Center may be provided by the facility as well as by other health care providers who may separately bill the patient. Those separate health care providers may or may not participate with the same health insurers or health maintenance organizations (HMOs) as this facility. Patients and prospective patients should contact each health care provider who will provide services in the facility to determine the health insurers and HMOs with which the provider participates as a network provider or preferred provider. Please contact your surgeon’s office for an estimate of separate physician professional fees.
